LETTERS PATENT -
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TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME - GREETING:

"WHEREAS, it appears that MUDBERRY EXPLOSIVE" AND SUPPLY COMPANY, a corporation existing under the laws of the State of Florida, at a meeting held for that purpose on the fourteenth day of March, A. D., 1916, duly called as provided by law adopted the following resolution:

"RESOLVED that under the provisions of the Statutes of Florida, and the Articles of Incorporation of the Company, the present name of MUDBERRY EXPLOSIVES AND SUPPLY COMPANY be changed to the name of MINE AND MINE SUPPLY COMPANY."

AND, WHEREAS, a certificate under the common seal of the Corporation of the said resolution, adopted as aforesaid, was duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State, and it appearing that the resolution will be beneficial and lawful and not injurious to the community, and is in accord with the purposes of the Charter, the name is therefore approved.

WHEREFORE, THE STATE OF FLORIDA HEREBY GRANTS unto the said Corporation, under the name of

MINE AND MINE SUPPLY COMPANY

full authority to exercise the powers and privileges of such corporation under and in accordance with its Charter, and resolution adopted, as aforesaid.
