

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATIOIN OF BILL BOZEMAN INSURANCE AGENCY, INC



Pursuant to Section 607.1006 of the Florida Statutes, the Articles of Incorporation of BILL BOZEMAN INSURANCE AGENCY, INC. are hereby amended as follows:

1. Article I is hereby amended in its entirety to now read as follows:

"ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be BOZEMAN INSURANCE, INC."

2. Article II is hereby amended in its entirety to now read as follows:

"ARTICLE II - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is: To act as agent or brokers for insurance companies in soliciting and receiving applications for firs, casualty, plate glass, automobiles, trucks and other motor vehicles, boiler, elevator, accident, health, burglary, rent, marine, credit, and life insurance, and all other kinds of insurance, the collection of premiums, and doing such other business as may be delegated to agents and insurance brokerage business;

To act as the agent of such persons, firms, associations and corporations as shall employ it to investigate, collect, and report information concerning applications, applicants, and risks, and to prepare, present, adjust, settle, collect, and purchase claims arising under insurance policies, and such other business as is incidental to such business;

To purchase, acquire, and take over the business of insurance agencies, as insurance brokers, insurance agents, agents of underwriters and of insurance companies, adjusters of averages and their kindered business; and

To engage in all other activities permitted by law."

3. Article VII is hereby amended in its entirety to now read as follows:

"ARTICLE VII - DIRECTORS

The number of directors shall be established by the By-Laws adopted by the stockholders from time to time."

- 4. Except as hereby amended, the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation are hereby ratified and affirmed.
- 5. The foregoing Articles of Amendment was adopted by the unanimous written consent of the Board of Directors and Shareholders of the Corporation in accordance with Sections 607.0704 and 607.0821 of the Florida Statues on the 13⁷⁴ day of 1607.0901.
- 4. The only voting group entitled to vote separately on the Amendment is the common shareholders of the Corporation, and the number of votes cast for the Amendment by such common shareholders was sufficient for the approval of the Amendment by that voting group.
