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**ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION

Pursuant to Section 607.1403, Florida Statutes, **The Bernard Levinsohn Printing Co., Inc.**, a Florida corporation, submits the following Articles of Dissolution:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is **The Bernard Levinsohn Printing Co., Inc.** (the "Corporation"). The document number of the Corporation is 384125.

ARTICLE II

The Corporation was administratively dissolved on October 16, 1998; however, the voluntary dissolution of the Corporation was authorized on December 14, 2004.

ARTICLE III

The dissolution of the Corporation was approved by the shareholders of the Corporation holding one hundred percent of the issued and outstanding stock of the Corporation entitled to vote.


ARTICLE IV

NOTICE OF DISSOLUTION
OF
THE BERNARD LEVINSOHN PRINTING CO., INC.

This Notice of Dissolution is submitted by **The Bernard Levinsohn Printing Co., Inc.**, a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"), to resolve and pay all unknown claims against the Corporation as provided in Section 607.1407, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I


