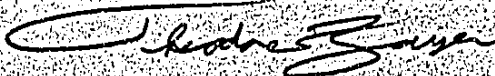

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of 2,000,000 shares at .0005 par value.

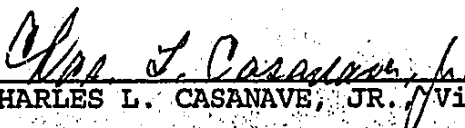
SECOND: Previously issued shares shall be exchanged for new shares at the ratio of 10,000 new shares for 1 old share.
