

Amended Articles of Incorporation of the Pilot Club of Ocala, Florida, INC.

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purposes of amending the Articles of Incorporation for the Pilot Club of Ocala, Florida, Inc, where membership vote was accepted unanimously on August 18, 2011.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be "Pilot Club of Ocala, Florida, INC.". The place where this corporation shall be located and where is shall conduct its business and affairs shall be in the City of Ocala, County of Marion, State of Florida. The street address of the initial principal office is 1950 SW 151st Street Avenue, Ocala, FL 34481.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are to serve as a global and educational organization of executive, business and professional leaders working together to improve the quality of life in local communities and throughout the world, and for other lawful purposes permitted under for organizations exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles. Notwithstanding and other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt fro federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any further federal tax code.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the Pilot Club of Ocala, Florida, Inc. shall consist of individuals in the Ocala area that have a heart for community service and are committed to improving brain awareness.

ARTICLE IV - DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, the remaining assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively for educational, charitable and scientific purposes or to promote social welfare to one or more organizations qualified as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARITCLE V - OFFICERS

The Officers of this corporation, who shall manage and conduct the affairs thereof, shall be a President, President-Elect, Treasurer, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary and a Board of Directors. The Officers and directors of this organization shall be elected in May of each year, in the manner prescribed b the By-Laws, and they shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and qualified, as provided by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VI – BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of this corporation shall be the Standard By-Laws for the Pilot Clubs adopted by Pilot International, 102 Preston Court, Macon, GA; however, the corporation may establish standing rules pertinent to local problems not contradictory, nor inconsistent with the Standard By-Laws for Pilot Clubs and the By-Laws of Pilot International.

The By-Laws of this corporation may be amended only by a two-thirds vote of the delegates present and voting thereon at any convention of Pilot International.

ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed and adopted by any business meeting by vote of a majority of the members present, provided that notice of proposed changes shall have been given to all members at the previous business meeting, in the same manner that Standing Rules are proposed, adopted or amended.

ARTICLE VIII – INCORPORATORS/INITIAL OFFICERS
