Amendments to Certificate of Incorporation Of

Palmer Trinity Private School, Inc. (a Florida Corporation, Not for Profit)

Articles II, VII and IX of the Certificate of Incorporation of Palmer Trinity Private School, Inc., a Florida corporation, not for profit, are hereby amended to read as indicated below. The changes were unanimously approved by the members of the corporation at a meeting held January 19, 1999.

## ARTICLE II. PURPOSES & POWERS

Section 1. Purposes

Without in any way limiting the foregoing general purposes, the specific purpose of the corporation is to operate a private independent Episcopal school that provides an outstanding educational experience in a program that is academically challenging and fosters spiritual and physical well being.

#### ARTICLE VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs and business of the Corporation will be conducted by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors will consist of not fewer than fifteen (15) members, the exact number as determined in the Bylaws of the Corporation, as the same may exist from time to time

## ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENT

This Charter may be amended by consent of a majority of the members of the Corporation in any manner which does not contravene the purposes of the Corporation as set out in this Charter or would not adversely affect its status as an organization qualifying under Section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
