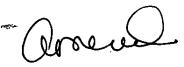

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

THE NAVAL AVIATION MUSEUM FOUNDATION, INC.

This amendment is adopted to change ARTICLE II of the ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION by deleting ARTICLE II of the ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION and replacing ARTICLE II with the following language:
