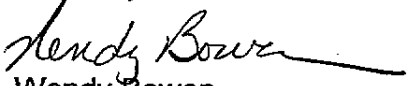

REVISED
CORPORATE CHARTER

OF

VICTORY TABERNACLE OF BARTOW, INC.

A Corporation not for profit

ARTICLE I

Name and Location

The name of this corporation shall be Victory Tabernacle of Bartow, Inc. Its corporate offices and primary place of worship shall be located at 530 West Hooker Street, Bartow, Florida. Other places for worship or corporate use may be subsequently established as determined by the membership of the corporation. This corporation is organized pursuant to the general not-for-profit corporation law (chapter 617) of the State of Florida and was originally certified by the Florida Secretary of State on 29 June 1967. This revision dated 6 January 2001 identifies current subscribers and officers, and implements updated by-laws approved by a majority of corporation members.

ARTICLE II

Purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized

The purpose, or purposes, for which the corporation is organized shall be as follows:

- A. To establish and maintain a place or places of worship of the Triune God as defined in the Holy Bible (God the Father, God the Son as revealed in Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit that empowers Christians to do God's work here on earth.)
- B. To evangelize and minister to the Bartow community, and elsewhere, in accordance with the great commission of Jesus Christ and His teachings.
- C. To train, license and ordain ministers of the gospel, missionaries and gospel workers.
- D. To carry on educational, charitable and missionary work for the purpose of advancing God's kingdom.

- E. To collect tithes, gifts and offerings and appropriate the same for the support of the ministry programs and objectives of the corporation. Special gifts and offerings may also be collected for building and maintenance of sanctuaries for the private or public worship of God and other proper corporate use as defined in the church by-laws.
- F. To buy, sell, and acquire and own real and personal property for all proper corporate use as defined in the church by-laws. The corporation shall have and enjoy, in addition to the above powers, all other rights and privileges incidental thereto or implied therefrom, together with such additional powers and privileges as are conferred by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes 1965, or amendments thereto. This not-for-profit corporation is organized and operated in compliance with the rules and regulations propagated pursuant to internal revenue code section 501-C-3 and its successors.

ARTICLE III

Qualification of Members and the Manner of their Admission

The membership of the corporation shall be identical to and the same individuals as all members in good standing at any given time of the Victory Tabernacle of Bartow, Inc. As defined in the latest revision of the by-laws of the church.

ARTICLE IV

The Term For Which The Corporation Shall Exist

The term for which the corporation shall exist shall be perpetual, or for that term as may be later determined by a two-thirds vote of the members.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VI

Officers of the Corporation

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer (who may be one and the same person) and by a Board of Directors of not less than five nor more than seven members. The officers of the corporation and other board members shall be elected annually by the members of the corporation at a regular meeting to be held in January of each year or as soon thereafter as possible.

ARTICLE X

Amendments

The articles of incorporation (Corporate Charter) may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of members of the corporation, present at a meeting specifically called for this purpose with two weeks advance notice.

The by-laws of the corporation (By-Laws of Victory Tabernacle) shall be made, altered or rescinded by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the corporation present at a meeting specifically called for such purpose with two weeks advance notice.

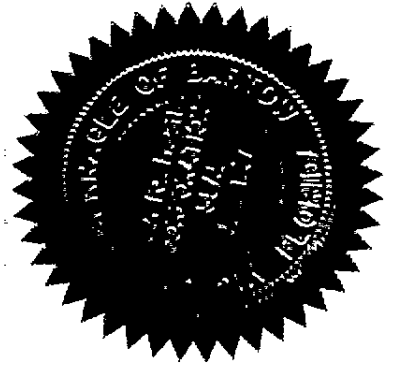
