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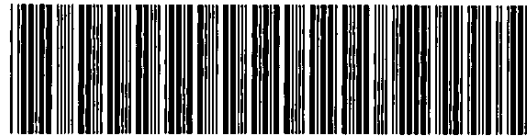

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

1. The purpose for which the Association is organized is to provide an entity pursuant to Section 711.12 of the Condominium Act, which is currently Chapter 711 718, Florida Statutes, as amended or renumbered from time to time, 1965, for the operation of PENTHOUSE DELRAY, a condominium, located upon a portion of the following lands in Palm Beach County, Florida:

ARTICLE III

POWERS

The powers of the Association shall include and be governed by the following provisions:

2. The Association shall have all of the powers and duties set forth in the Condominium Act except as limited by these Articles and the Declaration of Condominium and all of the powers and duties reasonably necessary to operate the Condominium as set forth in the Declaration thereof and as it may be amended from time to time, including but not limited to the following:

(f) To make and amend reasonable regulations respecting the use of the property in the condominium; ~~—provided however, that all such regulations and amendments thereto shall be approved by not less than 75% of the votes of the entire membership of the Association before such shall become effective.~~

(m) To borrow money and execute notes, pledge and security agreements and other documents in connection with any loan; provided, however, no Condominium real property (except for units owned by the Association) may be mortgaged.

#### ARTICLE IV

#### MEMBERS

2. Change of membership in the Association shall be established by the recording in the public records of ~~Broward~~ Palm Beach County, Florida, Florida, of a deed or other instrument establishing a record title to an apartment in the condominium and the delivery to the Association of a certified copy of such instrument, the owner designated by such instrument thereby becoming a member of the Association. The membership of the prior owner shall be thereby terminated.

ARTICLE VII

INDEMNIFICATION

To the greatest extent allowed by law, Every every director and every officer and committee member of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a party, or in which he may become involved, by reason of his being or having been a director or officer or committee member of the Association, or any settlement thereof, whether or not he is a director or officer or committee member at the time such expenses are incurred, except in such cases wherein the director or officer or committee member is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the performance of his duties; provided that in the event of a settlement the indemnification herein shall apply only when the board of directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being for the best interests of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such director or officer or committee member may be entitled.
