




EXHIBIT 'A'

IT IS RESOLVED THAT the articles of incorporation of this corporation be amended in the following respects:

ARTICLE XII

Upon dissolution of the corporation and after paying or making provision for payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, the remaining assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational or religious purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue Law). Provided, however, that the distribution shall be made to First United Methodist Church of Fort Lauderdale, of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, if the recipient church qualifies; if that entity does not qualify, then to West Palm Beach District of the Florida Conference of the United Methodist Church if that entity qualifies; if that entity does not qualify, then to the trustees of the Florida Conference of the United Methodist Church if that entity qualified; and if that entity does not qualify, then in the manner determined by the board of directors provided the distribution is exclusively for the purposes to the exempt organization or organizations described above. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court for the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, but exclusively for the purposes or to the exempt organization or organizations described above.
