

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
THE CHURCH OF THE COVENANT, INC.,
THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN THE UNITED STATES

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 617.1002 and 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation hereby submits the following Articles of Amendment:

The following Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of THE CHURCH OF THE COVENANT, INC., THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN THE UNITED STATES, was unanimously adopted by the member of the Church at a meeting held on the __26th__ day of __0ctober_____, 19_97, and the number of votes cast for the amendments was sufficient for approval.

1. ARTICLE I of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF THE COVENANT, INC., P.C.(U.S.A.), and it shall be located in Sarasota County, State of Florida, at 7950 South Tamiami Trail, Sarasota.

2. ARTICLE V of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE V

The Elders in active service in the church who are eligible under the civil law shall, by reason of their office, be the Trustees of the Corporation. By majority vote, Trustees shall elect

annually from its members a President, Vice-President, and Treasurer. The Clerk of Session shall serve as Secretary.

- 3. ARTICLE VII of the Articles of Incorporation is deleted.
- 4. ARTICLE X of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE X

The business of the corporation shall be conducted as provided in the Charter and By-Laws and must always be in accord with the Constitution of the P.C.(U.S.A.).

5. ARTICLE XI of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE XI

This corporation is formed without capital stock and no pecuniary benefit shall ever be derived hereunder and no profit made by this corporation or any of its members. All right, title or interest of each member of this corporation in the estate, property, privileges or franchises belonging to this corporation shall cease when such member ceases to be a member of PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF THE COVENANT, INC., P.C. (U.S.A.), irrespective of whether or not the cessation of membership is brought about by death or otherwise.

The notice shall be mailed at least three (3) weeks prior to the date of the meeting.
