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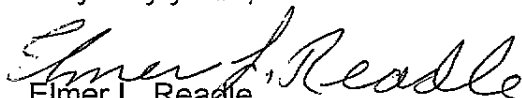

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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted:

Article I is amended to read as follows:

The name of the corporation shall be "HOMEPORT CHRISTIAN CHURCH, INC." a corporation not for profit, located in the County of St. Johns and the State of Florida. This corporation shall have all corporate powers as provided by this charter and Section 617.021 Florida Statute, 1967.

Article IV is amended to read as follows:

The "HOMEPORT CHRISTIAN CHURCH, INC.", is free in Christ and is not a member of any policy making convention and does not come under the oversight of any organization, society, diocese, secretary, Bishop, missionary society, council of churches, alliance or any other council or policy making organization.

This congregation is not connected with nor does it come under the oversight of any of the organization of the "Disciples of Christ" denominations, namely: Unified Promotion, United Christian Missionary Society, International Convention of Christian Churches, Board of Church Extension, of Board of Higher Education.

The government of this congregation shall always be autonomous. And in accordance with the teachings and precepts of the New Testament Scriptures.

Supporting of Christian missionaries shall be by the "direct support" or "faith support" method; that is, by sending our missionary offerings directly to the missionary or his forwarding agent instead of through a mission board or society outside this congregation.

SECOND: The date of the adoption of the amendments was July 14, 2002.

THIRD: The amendments were adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendments was sufficient for approval.
