AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION ST. GEORGE PLANTATION OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE VI

The number of persons constituting the Board of Directors of the Association shall be minimum of seven (7). And a maximum of nine (9) which number shall be determined by the Board from time to time prior to the next election of directors.
