

ADOPTED AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GLENWOOD MOBILE HOME COMMUNITY, INC.

1. Adopted amendment to Article I, As follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be GLENWOOD MOBILE HOME COMMUNITY ESTATES, INC. . . .

2. Adopted amendment to Article V, As follows:

ARTICLE V

DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The Board shall consist of seven (7) elected Directors. Members of the Board of Directors shall be elected to hold office, and be removed and replaced in the manner provided by the By-Laws.
