 - Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is deleted in its entirety, and (a) replaced with the following Article III:

ARTICLE III. MEMBERS

Any person may become a member of the corporation who is elected as such by the thenexisting members. The initial members shall be selected by the initial Board of Directors on such terms as the Board of Directors shall determine. The number, terms, duties, classes and designations of members shall be fixed in the bylaws of the corporation.

The foregoing amendment was adopted by a vote of the Corporation's Board of Directors at a duly 3. called and noticed meeting on the 10th day of September, 2001, which vote was sufficient for the amendment's approval.
