

# Village South of Carrollwood, Incorporated 2001 Annual Meeting

The 2001 annual meeting of the Village South of Carrollwood, Inc. was held on Tuesday, January 23<sup>rd</sup> 2001 at Lake Magdalene United Methodist Church. With a 2/3 quorum of Homeowners present, either in attendance or by proxy, President Dan Armstrong called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM.

Dan called for a moment of silence for two of our neighbors, Joe Parziale and Linda Howell, who we lost last year.

Secretary Michelle Gehrig read the Minutes from the 2000 Annual Meeting. A motion was made to accept and approve the minutes. The motion was seconded and passed.

### Old Business:

Dan reviewed the accomplishments and maintenance that occurred over 2000:

- > Landscaping which was headed up by Norm Prenzel:
  - The tree was replaced at the corner of Cartnal and Water Oaks.
  - Two Crepe Myrtles are plated at the far side of the pond that will eventually include a small plaque in honor of Linda Howell.
  - Quarterly change of planting at the Casey Road entrance.
- > There is a new home in the Community at the east end of Meadow Hill Drive.
- The Crime Watch book for 2001 is complete. Norm Prenzel passed out books to homeowners who were present at the meeting. He expressed his appreciation to Karen Allsteadt and Mercy Powell for their help. If changes occur that homeowners want noted in the Crime Watch book, those changes can be posted to <a href="https://www.tbhoa.com">www.tbhoa.com</a>. You will be required to enter a username and password and then will be able to see the same information that is in the Crime Watch book and make changes to your own information. Information about how to obtain your username and password is forthcoming.

Norm noted that because this information is confidential (i.e. some homeowners have unlisted telephone numbers, etc.) that this information should not be shared outside the community. It was noted that a burglary occurred over Christmas and many residents were not informed. It was suggested that a meeting of all crime watch captains be held. Karen Allsteadt volunteered to take over as Crime Watch captain from Beth Rashbaum.

### Deed Restrictions

During the past year, 25 letters were written to violators of the deed restrictions. Those violators who did not take action were pursued with the help of our attorney, Frank Friscia, and some progress was made. The Association did incur some legal expenses as a result. However, the legal expenses can be reclaimed from the homeowner in violation.

Dan further noted that those who receive letters citing violations should not take it personally, it is strictly business. When each of us purchased a home in this neighborhood, we agreed to abide by the deed restrictions. Overall, most homeowners are doing their part. Comments were made that the neighborhood improvements were obvious.

- > Dan thanked everyone who participated to stop Hillsborough County from making Water Oaks a one way street at Cartnal.
- Dan noted that presently all homeowners are current with their annual dues. A question was raised regarding legal expenses and whether they can be passed on to the homeowner in arrears. In fact, any legal expenses incurred by the Association while collecting delinquent dues or while enforcing deed restrictions are passed onto the homeowner. If the case goes to court and the Association wins, the homeowner is responsible for the legal expenses incurred by the Association.
