PREAMBLE. The undersigned corporation desires to transfer its corporate domicile from the State of Missouri to the State of Ohio pursuant to the approval of the Ohio Superintendent of Insurance under the authority of Section 3913.40 of the Ohio Revised Code, as it now exists or may hereafter be amended, and to be recognized as a corporation from its original date of incorporation of September 27, 1979, in the State of Wisconsin.

On September 27, 1979, Wausau Insurance Company B was incorporated in Wisconsin. The corporation changed its name to Worldwide Underwriters Insurance Company on January 1, 1980. On October 22, 1991, Worldwide Underwriters Insurance Company redomiciled to Missouri. The Articles of Incorporation were Amended and Restated on August 7, 1992, as an addition to the previously filed Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation.
