Enclosed please find a copy of your office's letter dated June 12, 2001, dealing with annual report/uniform business report and penalty fees to be charged to the above referenced corporation to register to do business in Florida.

We respectfully request that your office consider waiving or reducing these penalties.

Even though Providence did conduct business within Florida during the times discussed in our application, there are mitigating factors. The only business Providence conducted was to manage an apartment building which offered affordable housing to seniors in the Tampa area (the development is known as "Bethany Towers"). Bethany Towers is owned and operated by a local church, and is a not-for-profit organization. In an effort to help this troubled venture get back on its feet, we agreed to defer our management fees until such a time as the venture was in the black. Thus, Bethany Towers owes Providence a substantial sum, which they hope to at least partially repay through a sale of the assets of the company. In fact, Bethany and Providence severed their relationships with each other in February of this year in order to stop the clock from running on the management fees owed to Providence in light of this potential sale.

Seeing as how we have not made any money on our business ventures in Florida, and they have been put forth in service to a non-profit entity, we feel the amount of the penalties charged against us are excessive. We would like to properly register to do business so that we can look into expanding our service network into your state beyond Bethany Towers. But we would hope you would waive or reduce these penalties. Our business losses in Florida are already pretty great, and even with the possible sale of Bethany to a third party, there is a large likelihood that we will not be made whole.

I would hope we could come to a negotiated amount that would be more affordable to us in light of our business losses in Florida. I look forward to working with your office to accomplish the registration of Providence Management to do business in Florida.
