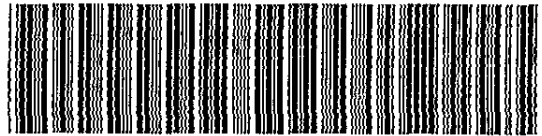

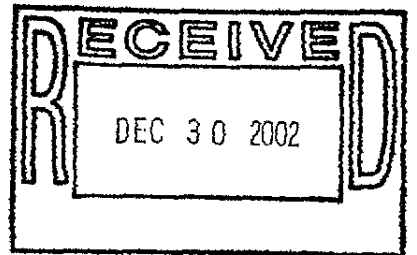

Please accept for filing, on behalf of the Republican Jewish Coalition ("RJC") (a District of Columbia nonprofit corporation), the enclosed Application by Foreign Not for Profit Corporation for Authorization to Conduct its Affairs in Florida (in duplicate original). Also enclosed in conjunction with the Application are the following: (i) a certificate of good standing for RJC from the District of Columbia; (ii) the transmittal letter; and (iii) a check for \$70.00, payable to the "Department of State," which represents the filing fee.

RJC first began conducting its affairs in Florida in September of 2001 for the limited purpose of facilitating member meetings and communications. At that time, RJC was not certain whether it would remain in Florida on a permanent basis, and did not file an Application for Authorization to Conduct Business.






