Ladies and Gentlemen:

Enclosed are an Application for Reinstatement for the referenced corporation and my personal check in the amount of \$365 for the \$200 annual fee for 1996 and the \$165 annual fee for 1997.

At the end of last week, in connection with some work I requested from my attorney, I discovered that the corporation had been administratively dissolved on August 23, 1996 for nonpayment of the annual corporation fee for 1996. I was surprised to hear this because I had never received either the 1996 or 1997 annual report forms or any delinquency notices from your office.

In 1995, I moved the corporation's retail location to another site, and I filed forwarding notices with the United States Post Office branch serving the old location. I also had individual notifications mailed to all parties that I was able to identify as needing such notices. I believe that forwarding address notices were sent to the Florida Department of Revenue and to your office, since the corporation operates a retail business subject to Florida sales tax and since we have received all correspondence relating to sales taxes. Evidently, the Division of Corporations does not have the new address of our corporation in its records, because we never received any notices from the Division pertaining to the annual reports for 1996 or 1997.

Our bookkeeper who would have been aware of the filing requirements left our employment in 1995, and her replacement was not aware that a corporate filing was required and therefore was not aware of any obligation to make a filing with the Division. I also was not aware of any annual filing delinquency, because I have always relied upon my bookkeeper to handle this task.

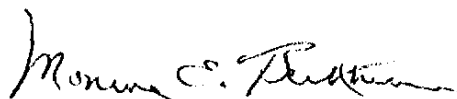
