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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF INDIAN SPRINGS MARINA, L.L.C.

The undersigned, desiring to form a limited liability company under the provisions of Sections 608.401 et seq., Florida Limited Liability Company Act, as amended, hereby sets forth the following:

Article I.

Article II. Principal Office. The mailing address and the street address of the principal office of the
