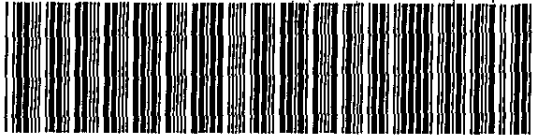



Merchant Properties - Greenbriar, L.L.C., a dissolved Florida limited liability company, executes the following Articles of Dissolution pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 608.445.

**ARTICLE I - NAME OF LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY**

The name of this limited liability company is MERCHANT PROPERTIES - GREENBRIAR, L.L.C. (hereinafter the "Company").

**ARTICLE II - EFFECTIVE DATE OF DISSOLUTION**
