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**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF

We further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

**ARTICLE I**

The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted, by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. **MEMBERSHIP RESTRICTIONS**
