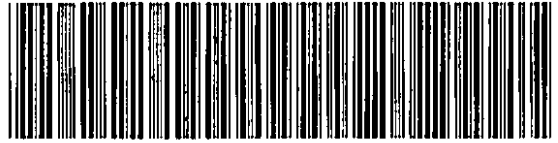

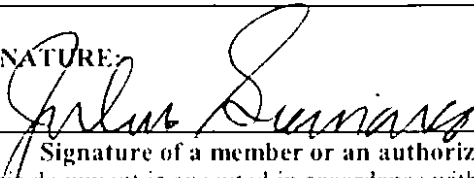

ARTICLE VI

The limited liability company shall be managed by one or more Manager(s).

ARTICLE VII
