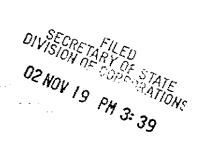

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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BROWN CONTRACTORS, INC.



Pursuant to Section 607.103, Florida Statutes, BROWN CONTRACTORS, INC., a Florida corporation, hereinafter called the "corporation" hereby amends its Articles of Incorporation as follows:

 Article I of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE I NAME
