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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

FOR

PHOENIX ASSET FUND L. L.C.

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SECTIVE STATES

A Florida Limited Liability Company (FS Section 608,401)

The undersigned, hereby certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a limited liability Company under the laws of the State of Florida pursuant to Fla. Stat. 608.401 entitled the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. We do hereby adopt the following Articles as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of such limited liability company.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be <u>PHOENIX ASSET FUND I</u>, L.C., and its principal place of business shall be located at 7501 Pembroke Road, Pembroke Pines, Broward County, Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at such place or places as may be designated by the members.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The period of this Company's duration shall be not more than 30 years, unless terminated by the unanimous written agreement of all members or by the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion,

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bankruptcy or dissolution of a member or upon the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member, unless the business of the Company is continued by the consent of all the remaining members, or by amendment of these Articles of Organization providing for the continued existence of the Company subsequent to the foregoing events.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES AND POWERS

The nature of the business or businesses to be transacted and which this ilmited liability company is authorized to transact, in addition to those authorized by the laws of the State of Florida, and the powers of the limited liability company, shall be as follows:

- 1. To engage in any activity or business authorized under the Fiorida Statutes
- 2. In general, to carry on any and all incidental business; to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, and to do any and all things herein set forth to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.
- 3. To purchase or otherwise acquire, undertake, carry on, improve, or develop, all or any of the business, good will, rights, assets, and liabilities of any person, firm, association, or corporation carrying on any kind of business of a similar meters to that which this limited liability company is authorized to carry on, pursuant to the provisions of the Articles; and to hold, utilize, and in any manner dispose of the rights and property so acquired.
- To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any parson, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or any domestic or foreign state,

government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative aubdivision, or department thereof, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts.

- 5. To exercise all or any of the limited liability company powers, and to carry out all or any of the purpooses, enumerated berein otherwise granted or permitted by law, while acting an agent, nomines, or attorney-in-fact for any persons or corporations, and perform and service under contract or otherwise for any corporation, joint stock company, association, partnership, firm, syndicate, individual, or other entity, and in such capacity or under such arrangement develop, improve, stabilize, strengthen, or extend the property and commercial interest thereof, and to aid, assist, or participate in any lawful enterprise in connection therewith or incidental to such agency, representation, or service, and to render any other service or assistance insofar as it lawfully may under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit.
- 6. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with others incidental or petaining to, or going our of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 7. The several clauses in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or

restricted by reference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

Nothing herein contained shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under the laws of the State of Florida, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

ARTICLE IV

CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Capital contributions in the amount of \$1000.00 dollars in cash or property are being contributed to the limited liability company by its members. Additional contributions of \$_____ dollars shall be made by all members of the limited liability company when such contributions are due and payable. A Member shall not receive out of the limited liability company property any part of his or its contribution to capital until:

- (a) all liabilities of the Company, except liabilities to Members on account of their contributions to capital, have been paid or sufficient property of the Company remains to pay them;
- (b) the consent of all Members is had, unless the return of the contributions to capital may be rightfully demanded;
- (c) these Articles of Organization are canceled or so amended as to set out the withdrawal reduction.

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A Member shall be entitled to the return of his or its contribution in the manner provided for in the regulations of the Company,

ARTICLE V

PROFITS AND LOSSES

The members shall be entitled to the net profits arising from the operation of the limited liability company business that remain after the payment of the expenses of conducting the business of the limited liability company. Each member shall be entitled to a distributive share of the profits. The distributive share of the profits shall be determined and paid to the members.

All losses that occur in the operation of the limited liability company business shall be paid out of the capital of the limited liability and the profits of the business, or, if such sources are insufficient to cover such losses, by the members as agreed to in the Bylaws of this limited liability company. RESTRICTIONS ON MEMBERSHIP

Additional Members may be admitted upon the approval of a majority of the Members of the Company, upon the written application of such new Member, in the manner set forth in the Bylaws of this Company.
