## EXHIBIT A

AGREEMENT AND PLAN OF MERGER (the "Merger Agreement"), dated this 18th day of October, 2000, pursuant to Sections 607.1103, 607.1104, 607.1105 and 607.1106 of the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "Florida Act") and Sections 180.1101, 180.1104 and 180.1107 of the Wisconsin Business Corporation Law (the "Wisconsin Law"), between David's Bridal of Milwaukee, Inc. and David's Bridal of North Milwaukee, Inc., the Wisconsin corporations (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Wisconsin Corporations"), and David's Bridal, Inc., a Florida corporation (hereinafter referred to as "DBI" or as the "Surviving Corporation").

WHEREAS, DBI is the legal and beneficial holder of all the issued and outstanding shares of stock of the Wisconsin Corporations and deems it to be in the best interests of the constituent corporations to merge the Wisconsin Corporations into DBI;

NOW, THEREFORE, DBI and the Wisconsin Corporations hereby agree as follows:

- The Wisconsin Corporations shall be merged with and into their sole shareowner, DBI, which
  shall be the surviving corporation of the merger. Neither of the Wisconsin Corporations are qualified to do business
  in the State of Florida, the state of incorporation of DBI.
- 2. The Merger Agreement has been approved and adopted by the board of directors of each of DBI and the Wisconsin Corporations by unanimous written consent in lieu of a special meeting on October 18, 2000 in accordance with the provisions of Sections 607.1103 (7) and 607.0821 of the Florida Act and Sections 180.1104 and 180.0821 of the Wisconsin Law. A copy of the Merger Agreement was mailed to DBI on October 20, 2000.
- 3. Articles of Merger shall be filed with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations on behalf of DBI, pursuant to Section 607.1105 of the Florida Act, and with the State of Wisconsin, Department of Financial Institutions on behalf of the Wisconsin Corporations pursuant to Sections 180.1101, 180.1105 and 180.1107 of the Wisconsin Law.
- 4. DBI was incorporated in the State of Florida on August 29, 1990 under the name Phillie Bridals, Inc. An amendment changing the name of the corporation to David's Bridal, Inc. was filed on September 1, 1995 with the Florida Department of State.
  - 5. DBI was qualified to do business in the State of Wisconsin on October 24, 1997.
- 6. The Third Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (the "Restated Articles") of DBI shall be the Restated Articles of the Surviving Corporation.

- 7. All of the issued and outstanding shares of the Wisconsin Corporations shall be canceled without consideration upon the effective date of the merger. Each share of DBI before the merger will represent the same number of shares of the Surviving Corporation after the merger.
- 8. The officers and directors of DBI shall be the officers and directors of the Surviving Corporation and shall hold office from the effective date of the merger until their respective successors are duly elected or appointed and qualified in the manner provided in the Restated Articles and the By-Laws of the Surviving Corporation or as otherwise provided by law.
- 9. CT Corporation System is the registered agent of the Surviving Corporation for service of process in a proceeding for the enforcement of any obligation or the rights of dissenting shareowners of each domestic corporation party to the merger. The Surviving Corporation agrees that it will promptly pay to the dissenting shareowners of each domestic corporation party to the merger the amount, if any, to which they are entitled under Sections 180.1301 to 180.1331 of the Wisconsin Law.
- 10. Upon the effective date of the merger, the rights, privileges, liabilities, obligations, powers and franchises and all and every other interest of each of the Wisconsin Corporations and DBI shall be vested in the Surviving Corporation in accordance with Section 607.1106 of the Florida Act and Section 180.1106 of the Wisconsin Law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the constituent corporations party to this Merger Agreement have caused this Merger Agreement to be executed by Jan R. Kniffen, Vice President of David's Bridal, Inc., and Richard A. Brickson, Vice President and Secretary of the Wisconsin Corporations, on this 18th day of October, 2000.
