CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENTOF ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF SIDE OUT PIZZA . L.C.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT:

FIRST: This Certificate amends the Articles of Organization of SIDE OUT PIZZA, L.C.

SECOND: The Articles were filed with the Florida Department of State on July 26, 1999.

THIRD: Article V of the Articles, ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS, previously provided as follows:

The right, if given, of the remaining members to admit additional members and the terms and conditions of the admissions shall be upon the vote of 66% of the members.

FOURTH: Article V of the Articles, ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS provides as follows:

The right, if given, of the remaining members to admit additional members and the terms and conditions of the admissions shall be upon the vote of a majority of the members.

FIFTH: Article VI of the Articles, MEMBERS RIGHTS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS previously provided as follows:

The right, if given, of the remaining members of the limited liability company to continue the business on the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member of the limited liability company shall be upon the vote of 66% of the surviving or remaining members.

SIXTH: Article VI of the Articles, MEMBERS RIGHTS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS, as amended, provides as follows:

The right, if given, of the remaining members of the limited liability company to continue the business on the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member of the limited liability company shall be upon the vote of a majority of the surviving or remaining members.
