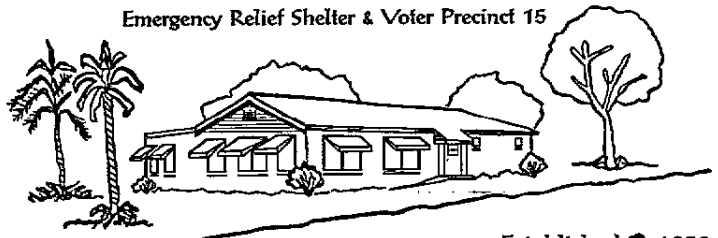

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
Rio Civic Club, Inc.
A Nonprofit Corporation

Pursuant to Chapter 617.0202, Florida Statutes, the undersigned incorporators hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is: RIO CIVIC CLUB, INC.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business in Martin County and mailing address of this corporation is:

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

To provide education and charitable assistance to the general public for the improvement of neglected conditions in Rio, the preservation of historic sites, environmental protection, and beneficial activities for neighborhood youth and senior citizens through publications, community consensus forums, self-reliance, volunteer projects and programs, collaboration with public agencies, maintenance of the Rio Civic Center as an emergency relief shelter, voter precinct facility and community center, and all other appropriate means.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

The number of initial directors of this corporation shall be five, and the names and addresses of the initial directors are as follows:

The Board of Directors shall be composed of four officers and five members to be elected annually by the members of the organization at a meeting called for that purpose. The officers of the organization shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

ARTICLE VI

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE VII

The membership provisions of this corporation shall be stated in the Bylaws of this corporation.

ARTICLE VIII - Additional Provisions

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.


No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or other wise attempting to influence legislation [except as other wise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code], and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.


No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.


