ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION

Under Section 617.1403 of the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, this Corporation submits these Articles of Dissolution.

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is the Joe T. Scholarship Trust, Inc.

SECOND: The Corporation's Articles of Incorporation were filed on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2000.

THIRD: The Corporation is a Florida corporation not-for-profit, and has 6 Directors.

FOURTH: On May 25, 2004, the Corporation's Board of Directors voted to dissolve the Corporation by majority vote. The number of Directors in office at the time of the vote was 6, with 4 Directors attending the Directors' meeting. Of those in attendance, 4 Directors voted in favor of the dissolution and 0 Directors voted against.

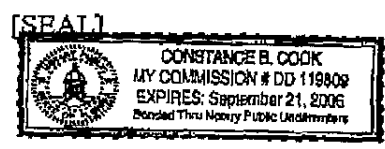

**PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION**

In accordance with Section 617.1406, Fla. Stat., Joe T. Scholarship Trust, Inc., a Florida corporation, not-for-profit, has adopted the following Plan of Distribution of Assets, upon Dissolution, effective immediately.

1. All liabilities and obligations of the Corporation shall be paid and discharged, or, in the alternative, adequate provision shall be made for all liabilities and obligations;
2. Assets held by the Corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution of this Corporation, shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.
3. All other assets of the Corporation, whether or not received and held by the Corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent, educational, or other similar purposes, but not held upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance by reason of the dissolution, shall be transferred or conveyed to Lake Sumter Community College to be distributed as scholarship money.
