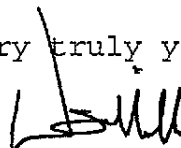

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

(a not-for-profit corporation)

ARTICLE I-NAME

The name of this Corporation is Christian Study Center of Gainesville, Inc.

ARTICLE II-INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the initial principal office of this Corporation is 112 Northwest 16th Street, Gainesville, Florida

ARTICLE III-COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these articles of incorporation by the Secretary of State of the State of Florida. This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV-PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business and shall be operated exclusively for non-profit purposes. No part of the income or assets of the corporation shall be distributed to, or inure to

the benefit of any individual. To operate a student christian study center.

ARTICLE V-POWERS

This corporation may do and perform all such acts and things, including those generally allowed by the laws of the State of Florida relative to non-profit corporations, as now existing, or as the law may hereinafter provide, as from time to time may be necessary or expedient to the exercise of any and all of its corporate functions, powers and rights. However, this corporation, in exercising any one or more of such powers shall do so in furtherance of the exempt purpose for which it has been organized as described in the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VI-MEMBERSHIP

Any person who agrees to be bound by these articles of incorporation, the bylaws or any rules and regulations which the board of directors may from time to time adopt, is eligible and qualified for membership in this corporation. The bylaws may provide the board of directors further discretionary power relating to the admission of members.

ARTICLE VII-MANAGEMENT

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs and business conducted and managed by the board of directors. Any action required or permitted to be taken by the board of directors, under any

provision of law, may be taken without a meeting if all of the directors shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by unanimous vote of the board of directors.

ARTICLE VIII-INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this Corporation is 112 N.W. 16th Street, Gainesville, Florida 32603, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is James W. Lynch, Jr.

ARTICLE IX-INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of this Corporation shall be three (3), and the name and address of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors is as follows:

1. James W. Lynch, Jr., 112 N.W. 16th Street, Gainesville, Florida 32603;
2. Jerry W. Davis, 8210 Bahia Blanca Street, Gainesville, Florida 32256; and
3. Judith S. Davis, 8210 Bahia Blanca Street, Gainesville, Florida 32256.

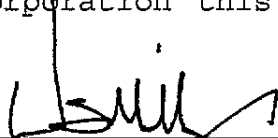
The directors of this corporation must, at all times, be members of this corporation. Only a member of this corporation may serve as a director of this corporation. The directors shall be elected annually by this corporation's

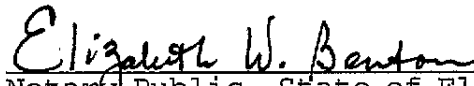
