The undersigned, acting as sole incorporator, adopts these Articles of Incorporation and forms a not for profit corporation (the "Corporation") under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act (the "Act"), as follows:

L <u>Name</u>

The name of the Corporation is Beef 'O'Brady's Marketing and Development Fund, Inc.

II. Term of Existence

The date when corporate existence will commence is May 22, 2000 in accordance with the provisions of Section 617.0203(1) of the Act The Corporation will have perpetual existence thereafter.

III. Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are to establish, maintain, administer and operate the BEEF 'O'BRADY'S® Marketing and Development Fund (the "Fund") for the Family Sports Concepts, Inc. franchise system of Beef O'Brady's® Family Sports Pubs restaurants (the "Franchise System") and all purposes associated with it.

IV. <u>Member</u>

The sole member of the Corporation will be Family Sports Concepts, Inc., the franchisor of the Franchise System. The qualifications, rights and activities of the member will be as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

V. <u>Limitation on Activities</u>

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation will inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any member, Director or officer of the Corporation or any other private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), except: (a) that the member at the time of dissolution or final liquidation

will be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the remaining corporate assets; and (b) to the extent that the member (or its affiliates) own or operated stores as part of the Franchise System. Nothing in these Articles restricts the Corporation from reimbursing the member for funds furnished or loaned or for services performed.

VI. Dissolution

Upon dissolution of this Corporation, or the final liquidation of its assets, whether voluntary or involuntary or by operation of law, except as and to the extent otherwise provided or required by law, the net assets remaining may be distributed only in accordance with the rules governing the Fund; provided, however, that nothing contained in this Article will be construed to prevent a distribution from the net assets of the Corporation to another distributee, otherwise properly made in accordance with the provisions of these Articles and the purposes herein stated, solely by reason of the fact that one or more of the members, officers or directors of the Corporation may be connected or associated with the distributee as a shareholder, member, trustee, director, officer or in any other capacity.

VII. Principal Office

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation is 505 East Jackson Street, Suite 308, Tampa, Florida 33602.

VIII. Directors

The Corporation will have 3 directors initially. Directors may be elected, removed from office and hold office as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time as provided in the bylaws of the Corporation, provided that the Corporation will always have at least 3 directors.
