ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporators, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

<u> ARTICLE I: NAME</u>

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

NON-PROFIT PURPOSE

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

SPECIFIC PURPOSE

The raising of funds to improve the lives of the youth at risk in Sarasota County living in public housing through providing necessary school supplies, hygienic supplies, counseling, after-school tutoring, and other programs deemed important to help these children grow into healthy, productive adults.

LIMITATION OF POWERS
