ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator to these articles of incorporation hereby forms a not for profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is The Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax code.

ARTICLE III.

The central purpose of this corporation shall be to provide assistance to the operations, activities and programs of the Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin, Inc.

All of the assets and earnings shall be used exclusively for the purposes hereinabove set out, including payment of expenses incidental thereto; and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles of incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

ARTICLE IV.

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Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to The Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin, Inc. and, in the event The Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin, Inc. is not in existence, to an organization which engages in activities which are reasonably comparable to The Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin, Inc.

ARTICLE V.

The qualification of members of The Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin Foundation, Inc., and the manner of their admission shall be as follows:

All persons interested in the scientific, education and charitable purposes of The Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin, Inc., and the advancement of The Junior League of Clearwater-Dunedin, Inc., and its objectives and who make contributions to the Foundation equal to, or in excess of, such minimum amount as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors, are eligible to become members of the Foundation upon approval or acceptance in any manner authorized by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI.

The name and street address of the incorporator of this corporation is: Gyneth S. Stanley, 1465 S. Fort Harrison, Suite 202, Clearwater, Florida 33756.

ARTICLE VII.

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 1465 S. Fort Harrison, Suite 202, Clearwater, Florida 33756, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Gyneth S. Stanley.

ARTICLE VIII.

The corporation shall have nine (9) directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time as provided in the Bylaws, provided that the corporation shall always have at least seven (7) directors.
