Article I: The name of the corporation is "Friends of the Breast-Cancer@mun.ca Listserv, Inc."

Article III: The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized:

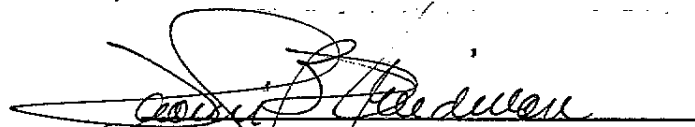

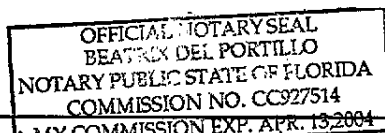

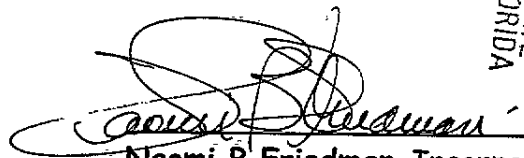
