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## **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

### **ARTICLE I.**

#### **NAME and IDENTITY**

The name of this corporation is GRACE APOSTOLIC CHURCH OF JESUS INC.

There shall be a logo uniquely identifying this organization which shall be established in the bylaws.

### **ARTICLE II.**

#### **STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE**

This is a nonprofit corporation organized solely for general religious, educational and charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit law set forth in Part 1 Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

### **ARTICLE III.**

#### **GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES**

(a) The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the furtherance of improving religious education, community service projects for the common good and general welfare of the community through religious, educational, scientific and other charitable purposes, by the distribution of its funds for such purposes, more particularly:

1. For congregating and sharing religious ideals and ideas.
2. Educate and inform the community about religious and social issues affecting the community.
3. Sponsor religious and educational forums and presentations bearing on the spiritual development and guidance that encourages healthier and better quality of life.
4. Provide coordinated access to religious organization for the enhancement of spiritual growth.
5. Assist and collaborate with religious organizations in order to improve the spiritual life and quality of life of residents.

(b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such religious, educational, scientific and charitable purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Code.

**ARTICLE IV.  
TERM**

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

**ARTICLE V.  
MEMBERSHIP**

The corporation may have a membership distinct from the Board of Directors. The authorized number and qualifications of the members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting, and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth in the bylaws.

**ARTICLE VII.  
LOCATION OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE  
AND IDENTIFICATION OF REGISTERED AGENT.**

(a) The county in the State of Florida where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located in the County of Palm Beach at 124 NW 5 th Street, Belle Glade, FL 33430.

**ARTICLE VIII.  
MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS**

(A) Board of Directors: The Powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be a minimum of SEVEN (7) provided, however, that maximum number shall be set and may be changed by the bylaws duly adopted .

The directors named herein as the first board of directors shall hold office until the first meeting of members, at which time an election of directors shall be held. Directors elected at the first annual meeting, and at all times thereafter, shall be elected and serve in accordance with the bylaws, and until the qualification of the successors in office.

Annual meetings of the Membership shall be held in December of each year at the principal office of the corporation, or at such other place or places as the board of directors may designate from time to time by resolution, or as provided in the bylaws.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the board of directors under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by unanimous vote of the directors. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by unanimous written consent of the board of directors without a meeting and that the articles of incorporation and bylaws of this corporation authorize the directors to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

(B) *Corporate Officers.* The board of directors shall elect the following officers: President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary, and such other officers as the bylaws of this corporation may authorize the directors to elect from time to time. Initially, such officers shall be elected at the first annual meeting of the board of directors. Until such election is held, the following persons shall serve as corporate officers:

## ARTICLE IX. BYLAWS.

Subject to the limitations contained in the bylaws, and any limitations set forth in the Corporations Not for Profit law of Florida, concerning corporate action that must be authorized or approved by the members of the corporation, bylaws of this corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to or new bylaws may be adopted, either by a resolution of the majority of board of directors or by following the procedure set forth therefor in the bylaws.

**ARTICLE X.  
DEDICATION OF ASSETS**

The assets of this corporation are irrevocably dedicated exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and/or scientific purposes as an exempt organization under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

**ARTICLE XI.  
DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS FOR ACTIVITIES**

No part of net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation. The organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

**ARTICLE XII.  
DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION**


Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to state or local government for a public purposes.

**ARTICLE XIII.  
AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES**

Amendments to these articles of incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the board of directors by the vote of two-thirds of active board membership.
