ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
IGLESIA DE JESUCRISTO, EL CAMINO, INC.

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SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

We, the undersigned hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida applicable to corporations not for profit, and respectfully petition the Secretary of State for approval of such incorporation under the following proposed Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the corporation shall be **IGLESIA DE JESUCRISTO, EL CAMINO, INC.**, and its principal place of business and place of worship shall be at 2110 NE Arch Street, Jensen Beach, Florida 34957, County of Martin and State of Florida.

ARTICLE II
PURPOSE

The general purposes and objectives of this corporation shall be to conduct for religious worship and instruction, churches, schools, parsonages, and other institutions connected therewith of a religious, educational, charitable and benevolent character to the end that its own members and others may be generally instructed and guided concerning those articles of faith which are most surely held among Southern Baptist Churches, and to advance spiritual growth and enlightenment, moral and personal purity among its own membership and the people of the community in which it is located; to promote home and foreign missions; and to aid in the spread

of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth; also, to educate, prepare and ordain Christian men for the ministry of the Gospel of Jesus Christ; and for the purpose of promoting the foregoing objects, this corporation shall have the right to acquire, either by gift or purchase, and to hold, own, sell, mortgage or encumber in any manner, lease and improve real estate and personal property for itself and others, either as Trustee, or otherwise.

ARTICLE III USE OF INCOME

All revenue, profit, income and money received from the conduct of such business or enterprise is to be used and employed in religious, educational, charitable, benevolent and missionary work and not for the benefit of the members of said corporation, either individually or collectively.

ARTICLE IV POWERS

Said corporation is to have the power to do any and all things necessary or expedient for carrying out the said objectives and purposes of the corporation and, in general, to possess all rights, privileges and immunities, and enjoy all the benefits granted to corporations of similar character under the law of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE V QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

Qualifications for membership, shall be regulated by the bylaws of this corporation.

ARTICLE VI ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP

The manner of admission to membership in said corporation shall be regulated by the By-laws of this corporation.

**ARTICLE VII
TERM OF EXISTENCE**

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of incorporation.

**ARTICLE VIII
NAMES OF INCORPORATORS**

Creg Collazo is a resident of Martin County, Florida; Oscar Caballero and Angel Izquierdo are residents of St. Lucie County, Florida.

**ARTICLE IX
BOARD OF DEACONS**

A. The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Deacons (subject to and in accordance with the bylaws of the Church) of not less than three (3) members. The spiritual interest and advancement of all departments of the Church shall be under their direction and supervision and they shall, in cooperation with the Pastor and subject to the By-laws of the Church, have general oversight of all the work of the Church.

B. Deacons shall be elected from the membership of said church corporation.

C. All elections to membership on said Board of Deacons shall be annually on the

Wednesday night following the first Sunday in September.

D. The membership of said Board of Deacons shall be divided, as at present, into three groups, so that the terms of office of one-third of the membership of the Board shall expire each year.

E. The said Board of Deacons shall, at their October meeting each year, elect from its own membership a chairman, vice-chairman and a secretary.

F. The Chairman of the Board of Deacons and the Secretary of the Board of Deacons are designated as officers who, in their official capacity, shall sign and execute all legal documents for and on behalf of the church corporation as its chief executive officers.

G. The regular meeting of the Board of Deacons shall be on the first Tuesday night after the first Sunday in each month.

H. The present Board of Deacons of **IGLESIA DE JESUCRISTO, EL CAMINO, INC.**, of Florida, and whose names are set forth herein, shall constitute the Board of Deacons and shall hold office until their successors are elected, and in accordance with their present terms, to-wit:

ARTICLE X OTHER OFFICERS

The other officers of the corporation shall be the Pastor, Church Clerk and Church Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board of Deacons may, subject to the approval of the Church membership, from time to time name and designate, and all such officers (except the Pastor, shall be elected by a majority vote of the membership of the corporation present at the annual business meeting of the corporation.

ARTICLE XI MEETINGS

A. The Wednesday night following the first Sunday in each month shall be set apart as a church conference by the membership of the church corporation, for receiving reports of the committees and departments of the Church, planning the program and activities of the Church, acting upon requests for letters of dismission, and for the transaction of such other business as may be proper.

B. The annual business meeting of the membership of the Church shall be held on Wednesday following the first Sunday in September of each year, at which meeting the annual reports shall be read.

C. All heads of departments, such as Sunday School Superintendent and Training Union Director, shall be elected at the regular monthly business meeting in August.

D. Deacons and other Church Officers (except the Pastor) shall be elected at regular business meetings in September of each year.

**ARTICLE XII
BY-LAWS**

The members of the Church shall have the right to make and adopt such By-laws as they shall deem proper and advisable and such By-laws shall be made, altered, or rescinded upon a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of the members present and voting, at any regular or special business meeting of the Church called for that purpose.

**ARTICLE XIII
AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS AND
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

A. The By-laws of the Church and these Articles of Incorporation may be altered, changed, or amended by the members of the Church at any regular business meeting called for that purpose, provided that proper notice has been given at a previous regular business meeting and, provided also, that such proposed changes have been submitted to the Deacons for their consideration prior to bringing it to the Church for consideration. The Deacons may express approval or disapproval, but final action therein is subject to the vote of the membership of the Church. All such proposed alterations, changes or amendments of the By-laws or articles of Incorporation must receive the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3rds) majority of the members present and voting at such meeting.

B. Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation, when approved by the Church, must also be forwarded to the Secretary of State of Florida and filed and approved by him/her, before the same shall become effective.

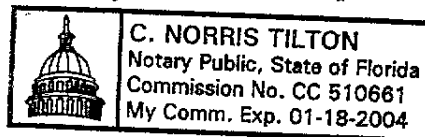

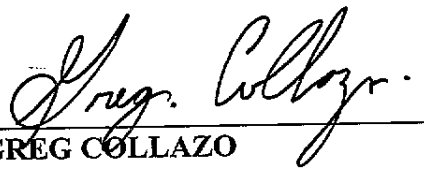
