ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

*** MODIFY ARTICLE II - PURPOSES ****

The purposes for which the organization is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 50l (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United State of Internal Revenue Law.

This corporation is a Not-For-Profit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

*** DELETE ARTICLE III - #8 DUES

*** INSERT ARTICLE VII - ORGANIZATION

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 50l (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- C. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consit of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

*** INSERT ARTICLE X II - CORPORATE ASSETS

B. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, Assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this Corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.
