ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

LIFE CARE OUTREACH MINISTR

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

Article IV-General and Specific Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: This is a non-stock, non-profit corporation. This corporation was formed for the advancement of world-wide ministry, religious churches, evangelistic development. Services that we will offer to our community are elderly, adult education, homeless and other social and health services. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3). Notwithstanding any other provision, the organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. Or corresponding revision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE V-Management of Corporate Affairs

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private person, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to take payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(C)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) and political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office or any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Upon dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning as Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections or any prior or future law, or to the Federal, State or Local Government for exclusive public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
