# AMENDMENT to FLORIDA ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION Of EXSULTATE! INC. N02000002812

#### ADDED AMENDMENT I - TYPE AND POWERS OF ORGANIZATION

#### Section 1

The Corporation is organized exclusively as a not-for-profit performing, educational, charitable organization to promote the study and performance of all genres of choral literature.

#### Section 2

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of , or be distributable to its members, any individual, any board member, or any officer, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes.

#### Section 3

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

#### Section 4

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### Section 5

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
