ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

TO

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE HISTORIC HAMPTON HOUSE COMMUNITY TRUST, IN Document Number N0200003784

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE VIII THE ORGANIZATIONS NON-PROFIT PURPOSES, POWERS AND DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The purposes for which the Historic Hampton House Community Trust is organized are exclusively educational and charitable within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the Historic Hampton House Community Trust, Inc. shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the Historic Hampton House Community Trust, Inc. will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

The date of adoption of the amendment was November 6, 2003.

The amendment was adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.
