## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION





## FLORIDA TURKISH AMERICAN FOUNDATION, INC.

(In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

## **ARTICLE I - NAME**

The name of the nonprofit corporation is FLORIDA TURKISH AMERICAN FOUNDATION, INC. (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

## ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 21614 Juego Circle, Apt. 25F, Boca Raton, FL 33433.

### **ARTICLE III - PURPOSE**

- A. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. The Corporation shall plan, design and develop a Turkish American Community Center as a place for cultural and educational activities.
- C. The Corporation shall advance education in Turkish culture, language, music, dance, arts and sports.
- D. The Corporation shall provide relief to the poor, the distressed, or the underprivileged.
- E. The Corporation shall promote the elimination of prejudice and discrimination based on race, religion, creed, sexual orientation, and gender.
- F. The Corporation shall promote the defense of human and civil rights secured by law.
- G. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors/officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and

empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in paragraph "A" above.

- H. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- I. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

## **ARTICLE IV - MANNER OF ELECTION**

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be stated in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

# ARTICLE VI- INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this Corporation is 333 West Camino Gardens Boulevard, Suite 204, Boca Raton, FL 33432 and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address is Dogan M. Bengisu, Esq.

## ARTICLE VII - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall have three directors. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time, as provided in the
