Amendment to Article III of Articles of Incorporation of the South Florida Blues Society, Inc.

October 15, 2002

Amendment: Article III - Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is "The South Florida Blues Society, Inc. is organized exclusively for both charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, for such purposes, the making of such distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code."

We will accomplish this through fund-raising activities such as music festivals and events part of the proceeds to be distributed annually to certain non-profit charities. We also will participate in the 'Blues In The Schools' educational and cultural programs teaching the history and fundamentals of blues music. Our purpose is to provide an outlet for fans to enjoy and support blues music, and encourage promoting, educating and advancing this American musical heritage.

"Upon the dissolution of the South Florida Blues Society, Inc., assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."
