ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

The undersigned, a person of the State of Florida, being competent to contract under the laws of the State of Florida do hereby adopt the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this corporation is The New Jewish Congregation, Inc., with its principal place of business located at P.O. Box 487, The Villages, FL 32158.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code of the 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United states Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

This corporation shall have only one class of membership, all of whom shall be voting members, provided, however, that neither the incorporator nor the members of the corporation shall have any vested right, interest, or privilege of, in or to the assets, functions, affairs, or franchises of this corporation or any right, interest or privilege which may be inheritable or which shall continue after membership ceases in the aforenamed corporation.
