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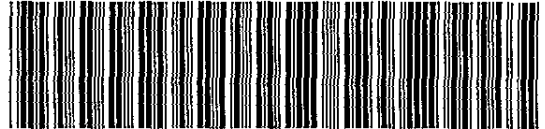

Articles of Incorporation

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I – Name

The name of this corporation is Seminole County TRIAD, Inc.

Article II– Principle Office

The name and address of the registered agent and registered office of this corporation is:

Article III – Purposes

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized shall be to further the goals and objectives of Seminole County TRIAD, a joint venture between the Seminole County Sheriff, the Chiefs of Police of Seminole County, the State Attorney, and the citizens/organizations having a major interest in reducing crime and victimization of older persons.

The Seminole County TRIAD has been established to garner the expertise of law enforcement, the network of community agencies working with the elderly and other seniors. The sharing of resources is the first step in achieving an effective means of identifying available programs. The process shall allow law enforcement practitioners as well as citizens of all ages in the development, implementation, and evaluation of acceptable solutions.

Seminole County TRIAD through the building of partnerships seeks to mobilize community resources to enhance the quality of life of senior citizens.

Article IV – Manner of Election

A. Membership shall be ex-officio and at large.

1. Ex-officio members shall consist of the Seminole County Sheriff, the State Attorney, and all the Seminole County Chiefs of Police.
2. At-large membership shall be open to senior citizens and members of community organizations concerned with seniors and senior affairs.

B. Directors shall be elected or appointed in a manner and for the terms provided in the bylaws.
