The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to provide a forum for interactive marketing practitioners, to share ideas and information among themselves and the professional, business, and educational communities, in order to help define and develop the interactive marketing industry and disciplines.

Except as otherwise provided in these Articles, the Corporation shall have all of the powers provided in the Act. Moreover, the Corporation shall have all implied powers necessary and proper to carry out its express powers. The Corporation may pay reasonable compensation to directors, or officers for services rendered to or for the Corporation in furtherance of one or more of its purposes set forth above.

The Corporation shall not par dividends or other corporate income to its directors or officers or otherwise accrue distributable profits or permit the realization of private fain. The Corporation shall have no power to take any action prohibited by the Act. The Corporation shall not have the power to engage in any activities, except to an insubstantial degree, that are not in furtherance of the purposes set forth above.

The Corporation shall have no power to take any action that would be inconsistent with the requirements for receiving tax deductible charitable contributions under Internal Revenue Code Section 170(c)(2) and related regulations, rulings, and procedures. Regardless of any other provision in these Articles of Incorporation or state law. The Corporation shall have no power to:

- a. Engage in activities or use its assets in manners that are not in furtherance of one or more exempt purposes, as set forth above and defined by the Internal Revenue Code and related regulations, rulings, and procedures, except to an insubstantial degree.
- b. Serve a private interest other than one that is clearly incidental to an overriding public interest.
- c. Devote more than an insubstantial part of its activities to attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise, except as provided by the Internal Revenue Code and related regulations, rulings, and procedures.
- d. Participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. The prohibited activities include the publishing or distributing of statements and any other direct or indirect campaign activities.
- e. Have objectives that characterize it as an "action organization" as defined by the Internal Revenue Code and related regulations, rulings, and procedures.
- f. Distribute its assets or dissolution other than for one or more exempt purposes; on dissolution, the Corporation's assets shall be distributed to the state government for a public purpose, or to an organization exempt from taxes under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(6) to be used to accomplish the general purposes for which the Corporation was organized.
- g. Permit any part of the net earnings of the Corporation to inure to the benefit of any private shazeholder or member of the Corporation or any private individual.
- Carry on an unrelated trade or business except as a secondary purpose related to the Corporation's primary, exempt, purposes.
