ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

TO

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LAUREN KATZENSTEIN CELEBRATION, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted:

A. ARTICLE II. PURPOSE OF CORPORATION is amended to read as follows: "This corporation is to solicit funds to be used to educate the public about the dangers of drunk driving and to promote and educate the public on all aspects of bicycle safety. Further, this corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and education purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to other organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specifically: MADD, Mother Against Drunk Driving, Federal ID#94-2707273."

B. A new <u>ARTICLE IX. DISTRIBUTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS</u> is added and shall read as follows: "No part of the net earnings of the Lauren Katzenstein Celebration Ride, Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for the services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the

organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code."

C. A new <u>ARTICLE X. DISSOLUTION OF CORPORATION</u> shall be added and shall read as follows: "Upon the dissolution of the Lauren Katzenstein Celebration Ride, Inc., assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Please of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."
