Articles of Incorporation

ARTICLE I	NAME UNAME
SECTION I	The name of the Association shall be the Florida Tech Prep Network, Inc.
SECTION 2	The FTPN shall be an affiliate of the Florida Association for Career and Technical Education (FACTE) through the Division of Tech Prep with all the rights and privileges inherent in that affiliation.
ARTICLE II	CURRENT ADDRESS Leona Miracola. FTPN Treasurer 3501 SW Davie Road, Davie Ft. Lauderdale, FL 33314
ARTICLE III	OBJECTIVES
SECTION 1	To serve as a unifying Network for all personnel working with Tech Prep programs and services in Florida.
SECTION 2	To unite state and local education, business, and community personnel into a state-wide network.
SECTION 3	To promote and maintain active leadership in the integration of academic, technical, career, and occupational education.
SECTION 4	To provide professional services to members of the Network.
ARTICLE IV	MEMBERSHIP
SECTION 1	Persons interested in Tech Prep programs may become members of this Network.
SECTION 2	Types of membership shall be defined in the By-Laws of this Constitution.
SECTION 3	Members are encouraged to join the Florida Association for Career and Technical Education.
ARTICLE V	DUES
SECTION 1	The dues of this organization shall be a sum sufficient to cover the essential services of this Network.
SECTION 2	The membership dues and method of collecting shall be established in the By-Laws of this Constitution.
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ARTICLE VI	OFFICERS
SECTION 1	The officers of this Network shall be President, Past President, President, Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, and five Regional Vice Presidents.
SECTION 2	All officers shall serve a term of office as stated in the By-Laws.
ARTICLE VII	ELECTION OF OFFICERS
SECTION I	The officers shall be elected by the membership of this Network.
SECTION 2	The Board of Directors shall appoint a nominating committee for officers of this Network.
SECTION 3	A meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held to confirm the eligibility of officers nominated before the annual business meeting of the Network.
ARTICLE VIII	BOARD OF DIRECTORS
SECTION I	The Board of Directors shall consist of the President, President-Elect, Past President, Secretary, Treasurer and Regional Vice-Presidents.
SECTION 2	It shall be the duty of the Board of Directors to determine the policies of Network and to carry out its objectives.
SECTION 3	Currently the Board Members are as follows:

ARTICLE IX	MEETINGS
SECTION 1	There shall be an annual business meeting of the Network and additional meetings may be called at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
SECTION 2	The annual business meeting of the Network shall be held each year at the time and place designated by the Board of Directors.
SECTION 3	The Board of Directors of this Network shall meet at least twice annually.
SECTION 4	A majority of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENTS AND CHANGES

SECTION 1

Amendments to this Constitution and the Network By-Laws shall be

governed by the Network By-Laws.

ARTICLE XI

PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The most recently revised edition of "Roberts Rules of Order" shall

govern the proceedings of the FTPN.

ARTICLE XII

ASSET DISTRIBUTION

FTPN is a perpetual organization with officer elections each year.

Should FTPN cease to exist the remaining assets will be distributed

through a scholarship program for teachers and students.
