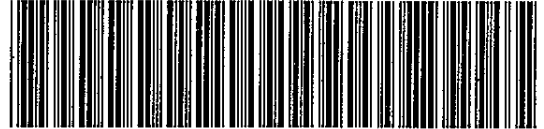

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

Central Gulf Coast Chapter of NIGP, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

Staten W. Corbett, 4200 Garrison Road, Panama City, FL 32404-9222

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- * Promote ethical, efficient and cost-effective public purchasing and material management.
- * To provide educational programs, products, and services for public purchasing personnel.
- * To enable public purchasing personnel to exchange useful information about policies, practices, procedures, products, and services of common interest; and
- * To otherwise facilitate the conduct of purchasing activities by government and other public agencies.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

- A. The Nominating Committee and its Chairperson are appointed by the President and shall consist of not less than five (5) members. The Nominating Committee will recommend a slate of officers for membership vote at the October/Annual chapter meeting. The slate of candidates will be distributed to the membership thirty (30) days prior to the October/Annual meeting. Officers and Directors shall be elected at the October/Annual meeting from the slate of candidates presented by the Nominating Committee and any eligible and consenting member nominated from the floor. A simple majority vote of those regular members in attendance, and by absentee ballot, will be required for a candidate to win election. Votes by absentee ballot will be counted only if submitted on Chapter's Absentee Ballot from and witnessed by another Chapter Member in good standing. The Nominating committee prior to the official vote shall receive the Absentee Ballot.
- B. In the event of a vacancy in any office, the position shall be filled by a special election held in accordance with the By-laws.
- C. No member of this chapter shall be eligible for any office or directorship unless he/she is a member in good standing.
- D. No two (2) members from the same entity may serve as officers at the same time.

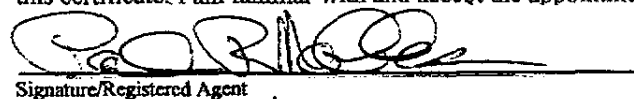

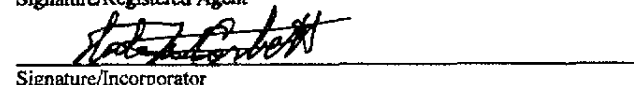
