ARTICLE I - NAME & PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The name of the Corporation shall be:

FRONTLINE EVANGELISTIC ASSOCIATION INC.

The principal place of business shall be:

ARTICLE II – DURATION

Frontline Evangelistic Association shall exist perpetually commencing on the date these Articles are filed.

<u>ARTICLE III – PURPOSE</u>

Frontline Evangelistic Association exists to evangelize and propagate the Gospel of Jesus Christ, by any available means, including but not limited to licensing ministers of the Gospel, teaching, preaching the Gospel, the calling of a pastor, the election of the official board, the discipline of its members, and the conducting of its own services and church programs in the United States, its territories, and in foreign lands.
